The 'Artisan Originals' collection has been curated by Jaipur Rugs and each piece has been designed and handwoven by local craftspeople with over two decades experience. Take for instance the rug named 'Khushboo' that has been conceptualised by Sunita Devi and Laxmi from Udaipuriya village - the women took inspiration from the rectangle boxes that make up the khatiya (cot) in their courtyard. Similarly, the 'Gochin' rug has been designed by Sajana ji who wanted to celebrate elements from his family home and local ceremonies. Accordingly, the rug includes diamond shaped motifs drawn from shakarpara, a popular village snack, and flowers that take inspiration from kalash, a pot weaver use for gardening.
